PENALTY

Suspension

You have been suspended for 16 weeks. You may resume playing on or after 9 / 1 / 2019

Whilst under suspension, you are not permitted to play, coach, referee or undertake scorebench duties in a competition or participate in other activities conducted by Basketball Victoria or any of its affiliated associations or governing or delegated bodies. You may not have any contact or communication of any kind with any of your team for 15 minutes prior to game time until its completion. Unless you are banned from venues, you may attend your team's matches but must sit on the side of the court opposite the players' bench. The suspension is also recognised Australia wide.

Banned from Venues

You have been banned from entering any venue in which basketball is conducted under the auspices of Basketball Victoria or any of its associations until 9 / 1 / 2019. You may not enter any of these venues for any reason. This ban is also recognized Australia wide.

Fine:

You/your team have been fined \$..... payable in weeks. The fine must be paid to the Association that conducts the competition your team was playing in.

Bond:

You/your team have been placed on a bond of \$ to be of good behaviour for months from this date payable in weeks. This must be paid to the Association that conducts the competition your team was playing in. If you are not found guilty of any offence during the bond period, you must apply for it to be returned. It will not automatically be paid out without a request.
