Nat thoroughly enjoyed her time with the Club, as a member of the Committee, an Age Group Manager and Parent of MMBC players. Nat, like the rest of us just loved to see kids on the court, from the U8 through to the U20s. She did a fantastic job and we are all grateful for her organisation and leadership.

Since coming into the role, I have had a steep learning curve. We have welcomed four new members of the committee and introduced a number of other roles and process changes. We have, under the guidance of Simon Waller, our Secretary and Website Manager, introduced new systems for the coordination of the teams across all age groups. We have introduced a new uniform supplier. Lisa Dearsley has worked tirelessly to achieve the transition and has improved the process markedly along the way. We have supported teams to get back to "business as usual" post COVID 19 lockdowns, whilst continuing to manage the effects of the pandemic ongoing. We have added 9 new teams to the Club and have introduced a "soft grading" process for our teams in the U10 to U14 age groups. We have paved the way for our Club to introduce teams to Westernport and Frankston Associations, and supported our relationships with Mornington District Basketball Association and Southern Peninsula Basketball Association.

Within the Committee we have farewelled Natalie Fowler, Rachael McIvor, Brendan Westworth and Cristy McCluskey. Thanks to them all for their support and coordination of their roles.

We have welcomed Cherie Petley, Melissa Shireffs, Kerrie Seager and Lisa Froumano. A very warm welcome to our new Committee Members.

We have introduced new roles including:

We would like to thank the many volunteers for their commitment to our club:

- Firstly, the **Coaches** and **Team Managers** for their commitment to the teams every week.
- Thank you to the **parents** and **players** who have been so patient as we have felt our way through the last few years.
- Age Group Coordinators who have borne the brunt of many of the changes introduced as well as assisting the teams to get back on the court and supporting them to continue though the challenges of COVID-19.
- Thanks to Simon for helping to streamline and standardise so many of our communication and admin roles.
- Thanks to Lisa Dearsley for managing hundreds of Uniform orders, negotiating with suppliers and for streamlining and improving our uniform ordering and delivery systems.
- Thanks to everyone for supporting our wonderful players, which is the reason we are all here.

We still have a couple of positions vacant to be filled:

- Uniform Manager (Lisa Dearsley is stepping out to take on the new role of Coaching and Player Development Support.) The Uniform Officer role involves liaising with our supplier and providing information to our members. The Uniform Officer also keeps track of the numbers on jerseys to help prevent duplication of numbers for players in teams and across the age group. Consideration is also given to the player's numbers in the age group above and below.
- Advocacy and Access Advisor (Vacant). This role includes assisting to ensure that the /club has the necessary procedures and information to enable an equal opportunity to all members of our Club. This includes supporting our members who have additional challenges when participating in sport, such as physical disability or obstacles to learning. We may need to advocate for special equipment or equip our Coaches with the necessary knowledge to fully support our players. We also need to equally support all our volunteers to ensure we have a truly inclusive Club.

Please consider taking on one of these roles, as many hands make light work.

We look forward to seeing lots of happy faces back on court for the 2022/23 Summer Season. Good luck to all our teams.
